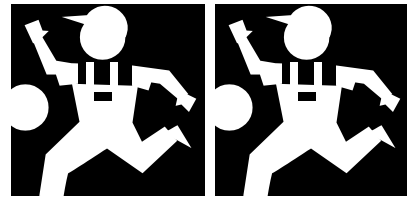

Fire Drill

We are having our first fire drill this Thursday. We practiced as a class and talked about what we should do for a fire drill. Some of the children may become a little upset when they hear the alarm sounds, but they will be less distressed if they know what to do. Here is what we told them about fire drills.

- We need to know what to do in an emergency.
- A fire drill is practice for what we should do in a real emergency.

- When the alarm sounds, we stop what we are doing and quickly line up at the door.
- We walk, and do not run.
- The children are quiet and listen for directions as we leave the classroom and the building.
- The children stay with their class when we are outside.
- Please discuss these procedures with the children as we prepare for our first fire drill.



Reminders:

All the children need a complete change of clothing kept at school. Store the clothing in a small shoebox at the bottom of the school lockers. Please provide these items so the children may be comfortable in case there is any reason to change. The clothing should be returned promptly after it is sent home. Items should include a shirt, pants or skirt, underwear, and socks and should be seasonal.
